

# What's Happening in Miss Patti and Miss Johanna's Class

## S Week



**March 5-9, 2018**

**Group Time:** The children will learn the S sound. They will play "What am I?" as they identify words/pictures beginning with this sound. The students will practice writing S and s in the air and on the carpet with their magic fingers. They will read road signs and other environmental print. Also, students will blend CVC (consonant, short vowel, consonant) words and read simple sentences.

**Writing:** The class will learn the proper starting positions to use when writing S and s. Also, they will use mirrors to observe their mouths (open, shut, tongue placement, etc.) when making this sound.

**Scribble Art:** The children will draw a squirrel.

**Art:** The boys and girls will cover the letters S and s with sunflower seeds. In addition, they will create a bowl of ABC vegetable soup with ABC pasta and construction paper.

**Building, Games, and Dramatic Play:** Space play, supermarket play, reading road signs and other environmental print, sea creature play, Nabi board, listening, and play doh with "S" cookie cutters are among center activities.

**Science/Social Studies:** The students will practice using a balance scale and discuss sea animals, seashells, the sun, and sinking and floating.

**Religion:** Patron Saints

**Math:** Number of the Week - 21

Work jobs continue. The children will practice counting to 100 by 1's, 5's and 10's. They will complete a class pictograph as children tell their favorite soups.

**Alphabet:** The children will complete puzzles and/or folder games. They will work on sound activities and visual discrimination with letters Aa - Ss.

**What you can do at home:** Find S's and s's in books and on signs. Find pictures and/or objects beginning with this sound. Practice writing S and s using D'Nealian style manuscript. Read road signs, restaurant signs, and other environmental print when riding in your car. Read labels in your pantry and in the grocery store. Have a wonderful week!
