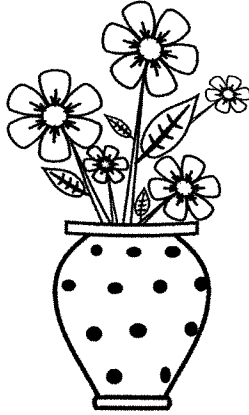


What's Happening in Miss Patti and Miss Johanna's Class

V Week



April 9-13, 2018

Group Time: The children will learn the v sound. They will play "What am I?" as they identify words/pictures beginning with this sound. The students will practice writing V and v in the air and on the carpet with their magic fingers.

Writing: The class will learn the proper starting positions to use when writing V and v. Also, they will use mirrors to observe their mouths (open, shut, tongue placement, etc.) when making this sound. Words and/or simple sentences will be written. The students will complete a V cut and paste activity.

Scribble Art: The children will draw a violet.

Art: The boys and girls will cover the letters V and v with vegetables. Also, they will create a vase of violets.

Building, Games, and Dramatic Play: Veterinarian role play, view masters, reading with animals, puzzles, Nabi board, listening, and play doh with "V" cookie cutters are among center activities.

Science: The students will learn about the parts of a plant. They will open a bean seed and find the baby plant inside. Also, they will plant seeds and watch them sprout.

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Religion: What happened to Jesus after the Resurrection?

Math: Number of the Week - 24

Work jobs continue. The children will complete a class bar graph of their favorite vegetables.

Alphabet: Alphabet recognition games will be enjoyed by all.

What you can do at home: Read to your children every night. Eat your favorite vegetable.

Find V's and v's in books and on signs. Find pictures and/or objects beginning with this sound. Practice writing V and v using D'Nealian style manuscript.

Practice counting as far as you can.
