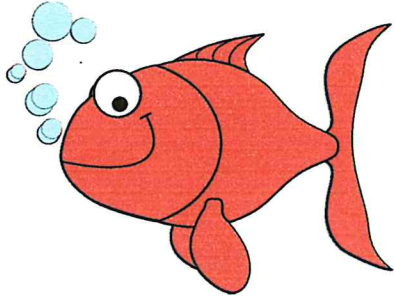


What's Happening in Miss Patti and Miss Johanna's Class

F Week



September 24-28, 2018

Group Time: The children will learn the Ff sound. They will play, "What am I?" as they identify words/pictures beginning with this sound. The students will practice writing F and f in the air and on the carpet with their magic fingers. The boys and girls will listen as *Rainbow Fish* and *One Fish, Two Fish, Red Fish, Blue Fish* are read. They will sing *Five Little Speckled Frogs*.

Writing: The children will learn the proper starting positions to use when writing F and f. Also, they will use mirrors to observe their mouths (open, shut, tongue placement, etc.) when making the sound of f. The students will trace Fernando Firefly and use templates to trace fish, frogs, and farm animals.

Scribble Art: The children will draw a frog.

Art: The boys and girls will cover the letters F and f with Fruit Loops. They will create *One Fish, Two Fish, Red Fish, Blue Fish* pictures and paint fall colored leaves.

Building, Games, and Dramatic Play: Firefighter play, fire truck floor puzzle, farm animals and barn, blocks, listening center, and play doh with "F" cookie cutters are among center activities.

Science: Life cycle of a frog and signs of fall will be discussed.

Religion: The children will be reminded that Jesus wants us to be kind. They will talk about friends, family, and the Holy Family. They will listen as the Bible story, *Jesus Feeds Five Thousand*, is read.

Math: Number of the Week - 6

Math Work Jobs continue.

Working on: counting with songs and calendar, ordinal numbers, counting the number of students who are present, number recognition and order, one-to-one correspondence, folder games and/or puzzles

Alphabet: Puzzles and/or folder games, sound activities, visual discrimination with letters Aa - Ff

What you can do at home: Find 6's, F's, and f's in books and on signs. Find pictures and/or objects beginning with this sound. Count to 30. Talk about being a good friend.

Other: If you were unable to attend **Open House** last week, a packet was sent home in your child's tote bag on Thursday. Included in the packet were copies of the alphabet and your child's name typed in the D'Nealian font. You may want to make copies of the name for extra practice at home. Please let me know if you need more copies. Also, a letter giving information about the Scholastic Book Club is included.
