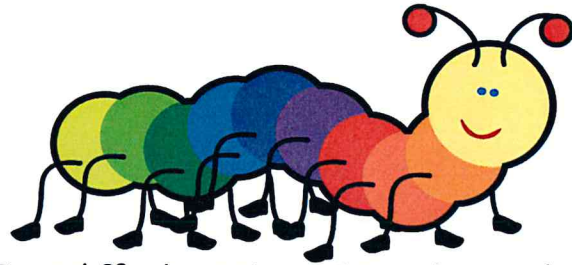


April News
